A clean winner for tennis

BUNDOORA Tennis Club has served up an ace. It's won \$60,000 in State Government funding to go with \$60,000 from Banyule Council to upgrade its courts and lighting.

The club has also raised \$80,000 through fundraising initiatives and loans.

Club president Jim McGregor said the improvements would help keep the club viable and competitive and attract youngsters to the sport.

Two red porous courts will be converted to synthetic clay courts and baseline surfaces will be rebuilt on two courts.

The upgrade will also see court lighting installed and new fencing on four courts.

Bundoora state Labor MP Colin Brooks said the funding win was a "great result" for the club and community.

Eltham, Wattle Glen and Kangaroo Ground tennis clubs also received State Government funding to improve their clubs.
