

Saturday Morning Junior Competition

Wet Weather Procedure

- All players must be present and ready to play, regardless of weather conditions.
- The nominated Home Supervisor, in consultation with the allocated assistant for that day, will decide if a washout is to be declared.
- **Players, Team Managers and parents** are asked to respect and comply with directions from the **Home Supervisor** in regard to washouts.
- When there is a possibility of a washout being declared, players are **not** to enter the courts for a hit-up.
- Courts are allocated to teams prior to the Saturday morning and these allocations are non-negotiable. It's possible some teams will be washed out while other courts are playable.
- If the courts are flooded, mopping up is not an option, as the courts will still be soggy underneath. Players risk injury and courts are damaged if played on in this condition.
- NEJTA Match Rules state that play will be abandoned if courts are not playable by 8:30am for singles and by 10:00am for doubles or late starts. *Time is a guide only.*

Scorecards for Washouts

- Names of players who are present to be filled in.
- Usual team names, fixture numbers and date to be filled in.
- **PLEASE DO NOT WRITE WASHOUT OVER THE NAMES!!!!**
- WASHOUT written in scores column and in the winning team spot.
