



REMINDERS – Players & Parents

Reminders for players...

- ▶ You must comply with the NEJTA code of dress and code of conduct. There is a copy of each on the noticeboard and on the website.
- ▶ Call faults and out balls clearly and promptly. **DO NOT LOOK TO SPECTATORS TO MAKE THESE DECISIONS FOR YOU.**
- ▶ Call the scores clearly before a new point begins. Keep track of the game scores throughout the set.
- ▶ **On the line is IN**, even if the ball just hits the back of the line.
- ▶ Have BOTH balls with you before you start serving each point.
- ▶ Good sportsmanship is important. Congratulate your opponents on good shots or sets well-played. Be a good loser and a gracious winner.

Reminders for parents...

- ▶ The Team Manager should not have to be present at every match. Parents should take their turn being team supervisor occasionally.
- ▶ When designated as the team supervisor, you must be present for the whole morning. Scorecards should be accurately and neatly filled in.
- ▶ Parents should **NOT** interfere with scoring or line calls during a set. It is up to the players to make calls and sort out any problems. They may sometimes be wrong, but parents should keep comments to themselves.
- ▶ Each team is rostered to help in the canteen 2 or 3 times per season. Please be there to assist when it's your turn.
- ▶ Encourage your child to display good sportsmanship at all times.
