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## Team Managers

Thank you to those who have taken on the Team manager roles this season. Your commitment is much appreciated, as was the attendance of at least one parent representative of every team at our recent Team Manager information evening. ## Mixed Doubles Tournament

The Junior Mixed Doubles tournament will be played on the first Saturday morning after the school holidays, Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> July. There will be an A, B and C Grade if we have sufficient entries, and there will be handicapping within each grade to make it more interesting. (For example, a lower ranked pair may be given a 15-0 start in every game when playing a higher pair.) Each pair will play three sets during the morning. There are still a few spots left so get your entries in by round 14, on May 27<sup>th</sup>. Cost is \$4 per player. You can choose your partner or we can pair you up.

On Saturday July 15<sup>th</sup>, the week before the real Spring season starts, we will be holding a Parents & Kids tournament.
