Next Season – Autumn 2007

All players intending to play next year must complete the registration forms and pay ball money by **Saturday 18th November** at the latest. Any outstanding membership fees must also be paid. Players and parents are reminded that there are no promises or guarantees as to which section you will be in or who your team members will be. All teams will have their stronger players and weaker players. We try to accommodate every player as best we can. Your performance and commitment over the past season and your team manager recommendations are used as a guide.

We are required to submit our teams with requested sections soon after our Registration Days, then the NEJTA begins its lengthy process of grading teams and organising fixtures. We are not notified of teams and sections for 2007 until late in January. Players will then be contacted by their 2007 team managers prior to the start of the 2007 season on Saturday 3rd February. Until then, nothing is definite - except that if you drop out for any reason after completing a 2007 registration form, you will not be cleared to play for any other club.

As always, volunteers are needed to be Team Managers next season. Some parents are happy to continue in this role; some have had their turn and are looking to hand over the job.
