## Welcome to the Spring 2007



Thank you to those who have taken on the Team manager roles this season. In several teams we had more than one volunteer, so if you didn't get the job this season, it doesn't mean we don't want you next time! In the teams with no volunteers, we had to do someone in. **All parents** are expected to help out being team supervisors on Saturday mornings throughout the season. The new season is underway and we hope it's an enjoyable one for all players. We have 9 Singles teams (6 boys and 3 girls teams) and 7 Doubles teams (5 boys and 2 girls). The water restrictions and therefore court restrictions are still in place. Singles teams will be allocated one court per team so it is essential that matches are underway by 7:45am. Singles players must arrive at their venue by 7:30am. Please don't be late; you could be responsible for your team having to forfeit a set. Doubles teams again have some early (8:45am) starts and some late (11:30) starts. Please check your rosters carefully. Players should arrive 15 minutes before the start time. This season we are hiring courts at Bundoora Secondary College for two doubles teams each week. Doubles will now have 4 players playing 4 sets (2 each) and the big change is that parents, not players, will umpire. Good luck to everyone!

All parents and players can help their Team Manager by being at home matches early to assist with watering and line sweeping, being there when your team is on canteen, taking your turn to umpire for the Doubles teams, taking turns as Team Supervisor and displaying good sportsmanship (players and spectators!)
